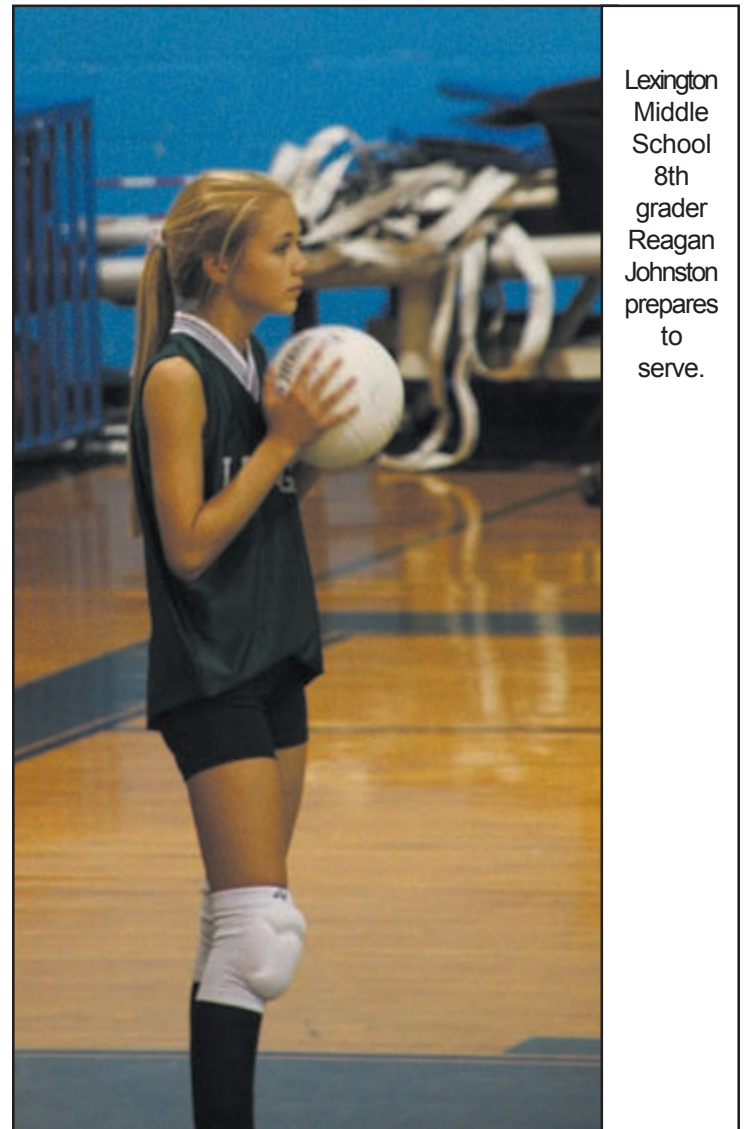
Members of the Lee County Express Track Club attended the Junior Olympics competition held in Greensboro, NC earlier this summer.

SUMMARY OF DECISION

Docket No. C4-0017-SC-01-C, Application by Alcoa Inc. for Renewal/Revision of Permit No. 1E

By Commission Order dated August 18, 2009, The Railroad Commission of Texas approved the application by Alcoa Inc. for renewal/revision of Permit No. 1E for its Sandow Mine located in Lee, Milam, and Williamson Counties, Texas. Permit No. 1E had authorized mining operations at the mine; mining is complete, and the permit was renewed for reclamation operations to continue. A request for hearing by the Post Oak Savannah Groundwater Conservation District was withdrawn. The Commission adopted two permit provisions. Permit Provision No. 1 includes a prohibition of planting certain non-native, non-local, or invasive plants. Permit Provision No. 2 specifies the types of surface water monitoring that must occur.

As part of the application, Alcoa requested approval of detailed design plans for 13 permanent impoundments, as-built plans for 8 structures, detailed design plans for 7 endlakes, plans for drop structures, plans for three creek restorations, and detailed design plans for two permanent diversions. These structures were approved as permanent. The application as supplemented includes updated information including insurance, ownership and control, revised impacts to wetlands and mitigation, updated information for groundwater and surface water monitoring, an updated determination of probable hydrologic consequences, and updated postmine slopes. Staff determined that no new cumulative hydrologic impact assessment is needed. The previous assessment determined that any potential impacts on groundwater or surface water quantity or quality are negligible.

The currently accepted reclamation performance bond is a self-bond in the amount of \$100,000,000; current estimated reclamation costs are \$82,247,714, an amount less than the accepted bond.
